
WinterFest 2024 Information

- Parade: 1:00 Parade starts at Community Park on 6th Ave. E. heads west, turns left on 1st St. NE, turns right on 7th Ave. E, crosses Main St. (Hwy. 27), turns left on 1st St. NW, right on 8th Ave. W, right on 2nd St. NW, left at 1st St. NW, crosses Main St., and returns to the Community Park.
- Santa: Will be located at the NE corner of 7th Ave & 1st St. immediately following the parade (at approx. 2:00).
- Over 80 food trucks and vendors will line the streets.
